It has been just over two months since we reopened our office to serve our neighbors in need. We have been blessed to serve many local families as they navigate these challenging circumstances. In this edition of our quarterly *Love Letter*, you'll learn how we have adapted these last few months to serve our community.



ELLA'S STORY

Love for Lane County is a "gap ministry". Each day in the call center is different and we never know what requests may come our way. A beautiful example of standing in the gap is Ella's Story. Ella* has been a client for several years and we have been able to support her in various ways. She recently called in with a difficult and painful request. Her veterinarian informed Ella that her beloved pet would need to be euthanized due to failing health. She knew that her physical limitations would not allow her to bury her pet at home herself, so she asked if we could find a volunteer that would be willing to walk alongside her through this difficult time. The Lord answered a prayer and a volunteer was available to assist the same day. While this is not a request we received in the past, the Lord found a way for us to support this difficult need.



MONICA'S STORY

Monica* called our office in need of household items and cleaning products. She had recently fled domestic violence with her young children and had to leave most of her things behind. Thanks to an outpouring of recent household donations, we had more than enough on hand to help this family settle into their new place. This sweet mom was thrilled to have all of the cleaning and hygiene products that she needed and that are so difficult to find in stores right now. We were even able to surprise this family with sets of handmade quilts, blankets, and throw pillows for each of the children. We were also blessed to have to opportunity to pray with this client as she begins this new season of life. Monica asked us to share her appreciation with you, that though this season is difficult, she knows she's not alone.

IMMEDIATE NEED FOR VOLUNTEERS

We are receiving many requests for yard work. These yard care projects are vital to our senior and disabled clients who desire to continue to live independently. All service



opportunities are no-contact and we have masks and gloves available for those who would like to use them.

In order for us to begin taking in donations of much needed household goods and furniture, we will need a couple of volunteers to **oversee sorting**, **cleaning**, **and sanitizing** these items to insure safety for our clients.

Our ride ministry is responsible for about 30% of all services that we provide to the community. As we begin to reopen this program, we need volunteers who are willing to help clients to and from important appointments, like colonoscopies. We are working alongside the Oregon Health Authority to create a framework that insures these services are managed in a safe and prudent way. This opportunity is important to our clients and rewarding for our volunteers.

Think of someone getting into an apartment for the first time, with none of the basics, this is a common situation for many of our clients. These basic items are needed to begin the next chapter. In the column to the right, you will see a list of our most frequently requested items.

At this time, we are unable to do any pick-ups of donations, or to deliver any furniture to our clients. So furniture donations need to be small enough to fit inside a sedan, or back of a pick- up truck, and the like. We continue to need clean beds and mattresses, especially twin sizes. 
